

Adding to Your E-Portfolio Content Area

Standard four of the content area is not something that a universal template can be applied to. Each content area has its own set of standards and objectives to be met. What we can do is teach you some techniques that will allow you to develop your content area as you see fit or according to guidelines given to you by instructors and faculty.

Your E-Portfolio Web template has a Web page dedicated to Content Area. It provides a place and links to your PDF artifacts for:

- 4.1 Utilize content knowledge to ensure student learning
- 4.2 Enhance content instruction through Colorado model content standards
- 4.3 Apply expert content knowledge to enrich & extend student learning
- 4.4 Integrate literacy and mathematics into content area instruction

However, you may want to add additional links or make changes to the Web page itself. This is where you will want to learn how to edit a Web page template and learn how to add additional links to a Web page. You might also want to add some different graphics. We have created instructions to cover these topics. It is important to note that these instructions are an introduction to editing these areas. If you are looking to make radical changes to the overall design of your E-Portfolio, you may want to consult a Dreamweaver manual.
